By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the impugned letter dated 28.03.2012 (Annexure P-5), issued by respondent No.2 and the impugned office order dated 20.04.2012 (Annexure P-6), vide which the claim of the petitioner for releasing the retirement dues has been rejected.

The learned State counsel refers to the communication received from the office of Principal Secretary to Govt., Haryana, Public Health Engineering Department and states that the sanction has already been accorded to release the 98% pension, commutation of pension and full gratuity in favour of the petitioner. Earlier the petitioner had been allowed 100% provisional pension. Now, the 2% cut has been imposed in the pension after the punishment order

passed by the competent authority on 27.10.2014, in terms of Rule 9.14 of the Punjab Civil Services Rule, Vol.II. He further states that the case regarding release of gratuity has been sent to the competent authority.

Keeping in view the fact that the entire benefits have now been released, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, the respondents shall make an endeavour that the benefits reaches to the petitioner without any further delay, preferably within eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
