AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Challenge in this writ petition is to the award dated 23.01.2012 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), U.T. Chandigarh.

There is no explanation for not approaching the Court earlier qua challenging the said award. Respondent (before the Lok Adalat) has approached this Court after almost a period of three years and four months. Apart from that, as per the award passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), U.T. Chandigarh, petitioner (before the Lok Adalat) has been found to be eligible under the scheme and respondent (petitioner herein) was directed to allot him an alternative site without any further delay.

The writ petition being filed after an inordinate and unexplained delay, stands dismissed.
