This Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, order or direction to the respondents to release due retiral benefits of the petitioner along with payment of interest for the delayed payment.

As per the reply filed on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 4 dated 21.04.2014, the GPF could not be released to the petitioner for want of Form No.10.

Learned State counsel submits that as and when this requisite document i.e. Form No.10 is submitted, immediately the benefit shall be released.

In view of the reply, petitioner is directed to file requisite document within three weeks from today and the respondents are directed to release the payment to the petitioner within eight weeks thereafter.
