AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the non-prohibited pistol No.3100647 bore .30 has been taken into possession by the Station House Officer, Ghanaur, Police Station Sadar dated 25.05.2014 (Annexure P-3) He states that there is no reason for doing so as the petitioner has not violated any of the conditions of the licence nor there is any case registered against him, which would entitle such an action to be taken. Counsel submits that the petitioner had sent a representation dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents, which till date has not been responded to.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 2 and 3, to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) and take further action in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to The District Magistrate, Faridkot and The SHO, Police Station, Rajpura, Distt. Patiala-respondents 2 and 3 respectively, to look

into the representation of the petitioner dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) and take a decision thereon within a period of four weeks. In case nothing is found against the petitioner, the consequential effect i.e. return of the pistol No.3100647 bore .30, be given effect to within a further period of two weeks.
