This writ petition is similar to CWP-7291-2014 which was disposed of by an order and judgement dated 22.04.2014. The petitioner has applied for renewal of its L-1 liquor license. The petitioner merely seeks an order directing the respondents to decide its application dated 20.04.2015 (Annexure P1) read with legal notice dated 20.05.2015 (Annexure P4).

2. The writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order and judgement dated 22.04.2014, namely, by directing the respondent No. 2 to take a decision on the petitioner's application (Annexure P1) and legal notice (Annexure P4) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of being heard. The same shall be done on or before 15.06.2015. It is clarified that no opinion has been expressed on the merits of the application.
