The petitioners, who are carrying micro enterprises in the field of transportation, are claiming benefit of the policy framed by the Government of India for Micro, Small & Medium enterprises, which contemplates that 20% of the work is to be allotted to such enterprises.

A perusal of the writ petition shows that the contract in pursuance of public notice has not been finalized. We find that the present writ petition is based upon apprehension and, thus, is premature.

Consequently, the present writ petition is dismissed as premature. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy after the tender process is finalized.
