Counsel for the petitioner states that the amount as has been pointed out by the counsel for respondent No.4 will be paid within a period of 45 days from today.

In case the amount as claimed by the respondent No.4 and pointed out by his counsel is paid by the petitioner within a period of 45 days from today, the respondent No.4 shall release the no objection certificate/no due certificate in favour of the petitioner. Till 45 days the interim order dated 14.09.2012 shall operate in favour of the petitioner thereafter it would without reference cease to operate.
