Limited prayer of the petitioner is for payment of interest on delayed payment of pension/family pension.

Plea has been opposed by learned State counsel on the ground that petitioner had earlier filed a writ petition bearing CWP No.11877 of 2010 in which direction was given to release revised family pension within a period of two months. According to him, there was no stipulation therein that petitioner would also be entitled to interest.

Heard.

It is evident that writ petition bearing CWP No.11877 of 2010 filed by the petitioner was disposed of by this court with a direction to the respondents to release the revised family pension. However, no direction was given as regards payment of interest.

Under the circumstance, a fresh petition on the same cause of action would not be maintainable. Even on merits, no case for payment of interest is made out.

Dismissed.
