AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that the order issuing warrant of possession dated 04.12.2013 (Annexure P-3) by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Barnala, has not been complied with. He contends that the matter was referred to the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Barnala, for police help. The District Magistrate, Barnala, asked the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, vide communication dated 06.01.2014 to provide for the required police help and to comply with the order but till date the said police protection/help has not been provided, which has resulted in non-compliance of the order passed by the competent authority/Court.

Petitioner has also submitted a representation dated 05.02.2015

(Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, which also

has not yielded any result.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the the Deputy Commissioner, Barnala, District Barnala and Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, District Barnala, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to take appropriate steps in accordance with law so that the order dated 04.12.2013 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Barnala, is given effect to.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, Barnala, District Barnala and Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, District Barnala, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to take appropriate steps in accordance with law at an early date.
