JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice (Annexure P-1) issued by the petitioner, and grant ex-gratia relief to the family of the deceased.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-1, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-1, by passing a speaking order, within a

period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
