RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

It is the case of the petitioner that he is identically circumstanced as Jatinder Singh who filed CWP No.10011 of 2012 which was disposed of with the direction to the third respondent to reconsider the issue that the petitioner actually fulfilled the required eligibility condition on the last date of submission of the application form and, therefore, there was no occasion for him to be granted relaxation in educational qualification as has been mentioned as a reason for declining relief to the petitioner in consideration of response to the show cause notice. In the light of the directions issued by this Court in Jatinder Singh's case, the request of the petitioner appears to be fair so that both, i.e., he and Jatinder Singh are treated at par.

Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the 2nd respondent to reconsider and treat the petitioner at par with Jatinder Singh who was re-appointed pursuant to the compliance made of the order dated 24.5.2012 passed in Jatinder Singh's case, the text of which has been placed at Annexure P-7 at page 35 of the paperbook.

Resultantly, in case a request for reconsideration of the earlier decision is filed within 10 days from today, the 2nd respondent would consider the same and pass a final order in the light of the directions in CWP No.10011 of 2012 (supra) within two months after presentation of the request for re-consideration.

The petition is disposed of with the above directions.
