In a nutshell the petitioners, who are presently serving as Head Masters under the Haryana State School Education Department, have filed the instant writ petition seeking the assignment of powers and responsibilities as have been envisaged under the Haryana Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 as also for the grant of drawing and disbursal powers in the light of State Govt. notification dated 15.9.2005.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, apprises the Court that the grievance portrayed in the instant writ petition has also been voiced in a representation dated 18.12.2014 (Annexure P-9) which is still pending consideration.

Without even examining the issue on merits, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent authorities/competent authority to consider the claim set up by the petitioners in the representation, examine the issue and to thereafter take steps as would be warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
