Writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner in Government Aided Schools and on Government Aided posts, for the purpose of qualifying service towards pension, and other admissible benefits. It is maintained that prior to the institution of this petition, petitioner had even served

upon the respondents a legal notice dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-8), but the same failed to evoke any response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition, at this stage, be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner within a stipulated period of time.

That being so, and without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as set out in legal notice dated 07.01.2015 (Annexure P-8), strictly in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed, assigning reasons in support of the decision arrived at.
