The present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for quashing order dated 24.4.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No. 3 on an application filed by the petitioner under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (in short 'the Act').

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the reference Court has passed another Award under Section 18 of the Act on 24.12.2014. In such an eventuality, a prayer was made by learned counsel for the petitioner to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file another application under Section 28-A of the Act by seeking limitation from the date of announcement of Award dated 24.12.2014 passed by the Reference Court.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
