Prayer in this application is for impleading Mohkam Singh son of Lal Chand r/o Nehru Garden Colony, Kaithal, District Kaithal as respondent No. 5 in the writ petition.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

Counsel for the parties accept the same and state that they have no objection to the prayer made in the application.

In view of the above, the present application is allowed.

Mohkam Singh son of Lal Chand r/o Nehru Garden Colony, Kaithal,

District Kaithal is impleaded as respondent No. 5. Amended Memo of Parties appended along with the application is taken on record. Registry is directed to place the same at the appropriate stage of the file.

Counsel for the parties agree that the Ad-hoc Committee may hold the General Body of the Society within a period of four weeks where the bylaws and the Collegium may be finalized as per the Rules governing the same.

Counsel for the Ad-hoc Committee-respondent No. 4 states that the needful will be done within a period of four weeks from today. He further states that the recommendations of the General Body shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Firms and Societies, Haryana, within a period of one week thereafter. The Registrar, Firms and Societies, Haryana, shall, on receipt of the same, pass a speaking order thereon within a period of four weeks. The decision so taken will be conveyed to the Ad-hoc Committee forthwith. In case the approval is granted by the Registrar, the election process will be initiated within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of the order. The elections to the society shall thereafter be held and completed in accordance with the Act and the bylaws expeditiously.

The present writ petition is disposed of in the light of the above consented order.
