Respondents No.7 and 8 have filed their respective affidavits. They are present in Court as well. It is averred that no construction has been carried out at the spot by anyone though the land was levelled. It is further stated that there is no sign of any fresh construction activity at the site and respondent No.9 has

undertaken not to carry out any construction till the matter is decided by the Court. Respondents No.7 and 8 shall ensure that no one else too is permitted to raise construction at the site till the matter is decided by the concerned Authority.

2. Since the appeal filed by Gram Panchayat where the title dispute is involved, is pending consideration before Director, Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab, it is directed that above-stated undertaking and stay order shall continue to operate in favour of the petitioners till their appeal is decided.

3. In case the appeal is decided against the petitioners, the stay order shall still continue to operate for a period of two months from the date of passing of order in appeal to enable the petitioners to avail further remedy in accordance with law.

4. Disposed of, accordingly.
