Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for quashing of impugned order dated 12.09.2013, passed by respondent No.4 (Anneuxre P-3) as well as letter dated 15.01.2015, issued by respondent No.3 (Annexure P-7).

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served legal notice, Annexure P-8, which is still pending.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-8, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
