Learned State counsel seeks to place on record the communication received from Additional Deputy Commissioner, Jind. Same is taken on record as mark 'A'. He submits that he has received instructions from Additional Deputy Commissioner, Jind, that petitioner would not have to bear the cost for re-modeling of watercourse. According to him, in view of decision taken by the authority, this petition has been rendered infructuous.
