Through the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 27.5.2015 (Annexure P-8) whereby benefits of extension in service granted to the petitioner upto 30.6.2015 has been cancelled midway.

The operation of the order impugned by the petitioner was stayed by this Court on 15.6.2015. In pursuance to the interim order dated 15.6.2015, the petitioner has undisputedly served the respondents till 30.6.2015 on which date he was relieved as the period of the service came to an end on that date.

In view of the above facts, learned senior counsel for the petitioner limits his case to the grant of salary for the period from 15.6.2015 till 30.6.2015 when admittedly the petitioner has served the respondents.

Without going into the merits of the case, since it is the admitted position that the petitioner served the respondents from 15.6.2015 till 30.6.2015 under the interim order of this Court, in my opinion, he would be entitled to the grant of salary for that period.

Disposed of accordingly.
