RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the impugned show cause notice dated 06.05.2015 (Annexure P-1), petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned show cause notice.

During the course of hearing, when confronted by the Court that the writ petition is prima facie premature, it being only against a show cause notice, learned counsel for the petitioner refers to an order dated 20.12.2007 passed by a Division Bench of this court in CWP-6578-2007 (Suresh Kumar Chahal and others Vs. State of Haryana) (Annexure P-2), whereby a similar controversy was dealt with by a Division Bench of this Court. He further submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case a similar order is passed in the present case as well.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the

rights of either of the parties, present petition is disposed of, with a direction to the competent authority, whosoever it may be out of respondents, to consider the reply filed by the petitioner to the abovesaid show cause notice dated 06.05.2015. It is further directed that the competent authority shall proceed further strictly in accordance with law, by passing a speaking and reasoned order, dealing with all the issues/objections raised by the petitioner. In case, any adverse order is passed against the petitioner, the respondents are directed not to act upon the said order, for a period of 10 days after supplying the copy thereof to the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
