Through the present writ petition, the petitioner challenges the order dated 24.06.2013 (Annexure P-2), placing him under suspension.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1, 2 and 5 states that during pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner has been reinstated in service vide order dated 20.02.2014.

This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, the order passed in the present writ petition would create no prejudice to the petitioner to his challenge to the charge-sheet through CWP No. 1330 of 2015.
