This Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of directions to the respondents to release the all retiral and pensionary benefits along interest @18% per annum.

On the last date of hearing, notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage submits that he will be satisfied if the directions are issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 04.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period. However, he further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any inquiry or no chargesheet is pending against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection on the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the assertion made on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner that no inquiry or chargesheet is pending against the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to examine and decide the representation (Annexure P-1), within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case after examination the petitioner is found to be entitled to the relief claimed, the consequential relief be released to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.
