By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondent No.3 to release the retiral and pensionary benefits along with all consequential benefits.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner on attaining superannuation retired on 31.03.2015. Neither the retiral benefits have been released to him nor the representations Annexure P-1 and P-2 submitted to the competent authority have been decided so far. It is contended that no inquiry or charge sheet is/was pending against the petitioner.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the matter and in case there exists no charge sheet or inquiry or any other obstacle in releasing the retiral benefits of the petitioner, the same be released within six weeks from recording such a satisfaction.
