Mr. Deepak Sabharwal, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana
accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Article 226
of the Constitution of India is to the notice (Annexure P/6) whereby the
petitioner was directed to vacate the Government accommodation by
4.6.2015 failing which penal rent would be imposed upon him with effect
from 5.6.2015.

It is the case of the petitioner that he has represented to the
Deputy Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon (Annexure P/7) that three of
his children are still studying at Gurgaon.

Counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the
instructions dated 6.6.2003 (Annexure P/8) to submit that on transfer the
employee is entitled to retain the Government quarter for additional two
months at normal rent subject to approval of the competent authority.

In such circumstances, it would be appropriate if respondent
no.5 is directed to take a decision on the representation (Annexure P/7)
moved by the petitioner within a period of three weeks from the date of
receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.

The present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
