AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a direction to the Director General, Department of Higher Education, Haryana-respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' on the basis of inspection which has already been conducted so that the petitioner can admit the students to the Under Graduate Courses as per the schedule fixed by the Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak.

As per the assertion of the counsel for the petitioner, CWP No.1180 of 2014, preferred by the petitioner was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 04.06.2014 (Annexure P-6) vide which the respondents were to decide the representation of the petitioner for issuance of a 'No Objection Certificate'. In pursuance to the said order, the inspection of the institute was carried out as has been mentioned above and no further clarification/objections have been

conveyed to the petitioner with regard to the conditions which are necessary for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' and the petitioner is not fulfilling the same.

Counsel states that the petitioner would submit a detailed representation to the Director General, Department of Higher Education, Haryana-respondent No.2 within a period of two days from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date so that in case the 'No Objection Certificate' is issued, the petitioner may be able to participate for admission of students to the Under Graduate Courses as per the schedule, copy whereof is appended as Annexure P-7.

In the light of the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' in its favour by the Director General, Department of Higher Education, Haryana-respondent No.2 within a period of two days from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided at an early date but not beyond 10 days from the date of submission of such representation. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Special Secretary of this Court.
