The grievance of the petitioner is that the nomination paper of the petitioner for election as a Lady Member, Gram Panchayat, Chak Khoiwal, District Fazilka was not received.

All disputes relating to nomination papers are to be decided in an election petition. Such is the view taken by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.2778 of 2015 titled Sukhdev Singh Patwari v. State Election Commissioner, Punjab and others, decided on 09.03.2015.

In view of the aforesaid judgment, we do not find any merit in the present writ petition and the same is thus dismissed. However, the petitioner is relegated to seek her remedy by way of an election petition.
