AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner contends that while preparing the eligibility/merit list dated 20.05.2015 (Annexure P-9) for the post of Labour Enforcement Officer Grade-2, the Subordinate Services Selection Board had totally overlooked the criteria, as was laid down in the Advertisement dated 16.10.2014 (Annexure P-3), which required, apart from the Graduation degree, two years experience of Labour Laws which should be of Government/Semi-Government/Limited Company with a pay band of ₹ 5910-20000+800 Grade Pay. He contends that two years experience of Labour Laws has not been taken into consideration at all. He further contends that the recommendations having been made by the Subordinate Services Selection Board to the Government, Department of Labour and Employment, Punjab, the appointments are likely to be made on that basis.

On considering the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the present writ petition is premature as it is for the competent appointing authority i.e. the Government, Labour and Employment Department, Punjab, to accept or not to accept the recommendations. Mere recommendation does not confer any right upon any candidate and, therefore, as of now, no right has accrued to the petitioner or even to the candidates whose names have been recommended. In case the recommendations are accepted and appointments are issued to the post of Labour Enforcement Officer Grade-2, which is not in accordance with the statutory Rules/Advertisement dated 16.10.2014 (Annexure P-3), the petitioner may approach the Court at that stage.

The writ petition is disposed of with above observations.
