This matter was taken up by this Court on its own motion on a note written by one of the Hon'ble Judges. While taking this note on judicial side, a direction was issued to the State and Transport Commissioner to file their affidavits explaining as to why no patrolling, whatsoever, is being conducted along the National Highway No.1 so as to ensure at least some semblance of safety on the highway.

In compliance of the directions police authorities have filed affidavits ensuring that steps are being taken so that discipline on the highway and all other roads is maintained through both the processes of education and penalization. Later, learned State counsel placed on record affidavit of Transport Commissioner, Haryana, indicating certain steps are being taken to avoid such kind of incidents on the G.T road.

In view of the replies filed and the stand taken by the learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of. We hope that additional steps would be taken to make travelling smooth on the Highways for the General Public .
