It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that despite inquiries held, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-2, P-6 and P-9, holding the officer-bearers/members of the Cooperative House Building Society as having embezzled an amount or having committed irregularities, no action has been taken by the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ludhiana, on the said reports. He further states that there are certain complaints, which have been filed, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-10 to P-14, which also have not been proceeded with. Counsel admits that the competent authority to initiate action is the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ludhiana.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ludhiana, to look into the inquiries, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-2, P-6 and P-9 and the complaints Annexures P-10 to P-14 and take appropriate action, if required, in accordance with law.
