Through the present petition the petitioner prays for the conclusion of the disciplinary action initiated against him through charge-sheet dated 14.12.2007 Annexure P-9. The petitioner was served with the charge-sheet for his willful absence from duty since 07.11.2005. The petitioner submitted his reply to a charge-sheet but finding the same to be unsatisfactory, an Inquiry Officer was appointed to go into the alleged misconduct on the part of the petitioner. The report was submitted by the Inquiry Officer on 08.08.2013. The punishing authority after going through the inquiry report issued show cause notice to the petitioner to which the petitioner had submitted his reply. It is the case of the respondents that the petitioner had been called for several times for personal hearing by the

Punishing Authority on several occasions but he failed to appear. Learned counsel for the petitioner disputes this fact. Be that as it may, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will now appear before the Punishing Authority on 19.08.2015 at 11 a.m.

If as per the above undertaking the petitioner appears for personal hearing, after hearing him and considering the grounds raised by him in his reply to the second show cause notice, respondent No.1- Punishing Authority will reach a final decision on the disciplinary action initiated against the petitioner within one month thereafter.

The petition stands disposed of with the above directions.
