Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for grant of the benefits of Assured Career Progression Scheme after completion of 8-16-24 and 32 years of service.

It is contended that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in ***Ram Dass Vs. State of Punjab and others***, rendered in CWP No.12132 of 2010, decided on 20.07.2011 (Annexure P-4).

Having regard to the nature of the order being passed, there appears to be no necessity to call upon the respondents to file their counter replies/affidavits, at this stage.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to examine the case of the

petitioner as to whether it is covered by the ratio of law laid down in Annexure P-4, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and if the answer is in affirmative, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a period of two months thereafter. In the eventuality of its not being covered by Annexure P-4, the competent authority shall pass a speaking and reasoned order on the representation, Annexure P-3, as per law.
