During the pendency of the writ petition, an order of recovery dated 20.2.2014 (Annexure R-1) has been passed which adversely affects the petitioner. It is admitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that against the above-mentioned order, a statutory appeal is maintainable.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to file an appeal against the order of recovery dated 20.2.2014.
