1. The counsel for the State submits that if the form of registration of marriage as prescribed under the Punjab Compulsory Registration of Marriages Rules of 2014 is submitted, the Registering Officer will examine whether all the legal requirements are fulfilled and proceed to take a decision on registration of marriage or otherwise. If it is to be registered, the same be done before 30.01.2015 and if a decision is to decline such registration, a speaking order shall be issued as expeditiously as possible and within a week. The direction for registration, if there are no legal obstructions, is given to a very short date, considering the plea made by the counsel for the petitioner that her husband's visa is due for expiry on 30.01.2015.

2. The order is passed in the presence of Mr. Karamjeet Singh, Naib Tehsildar, Zirakpur & Registering Officer and even if the copy of the order is not made ready, he has been apprised of the nature of order that is passed for immediate action.

3. The writ petition is disposed of as above.
