The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing order dated 30.04.2013, denying Form 'F' to the petitioner.

Sh. Neeraj Kumar, ETO-cum-Assessing Authority, Faridabad (East), respondent No. 4, is present in Court and has filed an affidavit, which reads as follows:-

“1. The deponent is Excise & Taxation Officer-cum-Assessing Authority in the office of Dy.Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Faridabad (East) and fully conversant with the facts of the case and is having the charge of this Ward-4 w.e.f. 27.11.2014.

2. That return in form LP-5 was submitted by the petitioner pertaining to goods purchased from M/s Ricela

Health Foods Ltd. Dhuri District, Sangrur holding TIN-03511014635. No adverse finding about the purchase has been given in the assessment order for the year 2011-12 pertaining to the petitioner firm.

3. That 'F' Forms can be issued to the petitioner-firm at this stage”.

Counsel for the State of Haryana concedes on the basis of instructions that in view of the aforesaid affidavit, order dated 30.04.2013, may be set aside.

In view of statement made by counsel for the respondents and contents of above affidavit, order dated 30.04.2013 is set aside and the respondents are directed to comply with contents of affidavit dated 21.02.2015. Disposed of accordingly.
