Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the salary, allowances and all other benefits of the petitioner along with interest for delayed period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already moved a legal notice dated 17.09.2014 (Annexure P/2), but no action has been taken thereon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case and without giving notice to the respondents, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievance
