By way of present writ petition, the petitioners have sought for setting aside of impugned order dated 11.06.2015 (Annexure P-6) whereby respondent No. 1 has transferred the petitioners from Faridabad to Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the aforesaid order dated 11.06.2015 (Annexure P-6), transferring the petitioners from Faridabad to Gurgaon on complaint basis is illegal, because there was no complaint against them. The complaint, if any, was only against Mr. Kunwar Pal to which the petitioners have no concern. No show cause notice was issued to them before transferring them from Faridabad to Gurgaon, which act of the respondents is violative of their fundamental rights. They have been transferred malafidely, because of their selection as office bearers of the Urban Malaria Field Workers Association, Faridabad in the election held on 18.05.2015 and hence, the impugned order dated 11.06.2015 may kindly be quashed.

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It is needless to mention here that districts Faridabad and Gurgaon are neighbouring. By this time, it is well settled, any employee can be transferred keeping in view the exigencies of the work. The petitioners have been transferred for a short period of sixty days and thus, they have no genuine grouse.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
