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Instant writ petition has been filed for direction to the respondents to distribute the land, articles belonging to the existing Gram Panchayat, Gram Fund, Bank balance, grants received from Government from time to time to the petitioner Gram Panchayat on the basis of ratio of population as required under Section 3(3)(ii)(b) of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.

In pursuance of notice of motion, respondents No.1 to 6 have filed reply, same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in view of order dated 16.09.2015 (Annexure R-1) passed by Divisional Deputy Director

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Rural Development & Panchayat, Ferozepur, present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous. If the petitioner still feels aggrieved, it will be at liberty to file fresh writ petition.
