Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners are seeking only a writ in the nature of mandamus, yet they did not approach the respondent authorities by moving an appropriate representation or legal notice before filing the present writ petition. He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioners shall approach respondents No. 2 and 4 by moving an appropriate representation within a period of three weeks from today and they may be directed to consider and decide the same, keeping in view the directions already issued by this Court vide order dated 15.7.2014 passed in **CWP No.21607 of 2012 (Raj Transport Co. Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar and others)**.

Having heard the learned senior counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should

prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the instant writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the District Magistrate, Amritsar-respondent No.2 and the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar-respondent No.4 that if the petitioners approach him by way of an appropriate representation within a period of three weeks from today, they shall consider and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law and also keeping in view the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 15.7.2014 (Annexure P-8) passed in **CWP No.21607 of 2012 (Raj Transport Co. Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar and others)**.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
