Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for granting of approval for intimation of development works at village Panchayat Raniyaki, from the fixed deposit account of Gram Panchayat Raniyaki.

Learned State counsel points out that tenure of Gram Panchayat has expired on 16.07.2015 and thereafter administrator has been appointed. Since there is no elected Gram Panchayat in existence, therefore, the instant petition has become infructuous.

In view of above, instant petition is dismissed as infructuous.
