- 1.) Notice of motion.
- 2.) Mr. Aman Bahri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Registrar (Recruitment) who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of the writ petition to learned counsel for the State as well as Registrar (Recruitment) during the course of the day.
- 3.) The petitioner appeared in the PCS (JB) Preliminary Examination, 2015 but having failed to qualify the same, seeks a

direction for re-evaluation/rechecking of the answer sheet and also to inspect the answer sheet as some of the answer keys are alleged to be erroneous.

4.) As regard to the petitioner's prayer for re-evaluation, there is no provision in the Rules, hence, the same is declined. As regard to the petitioner's prayer for re-checking or inspection of the answer sheet, Registrar (Recruitment) has informed that the petitioner had requested for supply of the copy of answer sheet (under RTI) which has been considered and she has been allowed to only inspect the answer sheet on 10.07.2015. As such, no action qua this prayer is required to be taken.

So far as the petitioner's challenge to the answer keys in respect of certain questions, we do not express any opinion on merits and dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the Registrar (Recruitment) to put up the matter before the three Judges Committee.
