In deference to the order dated 18.05.2015, Mr.Gurpreet Singh Dhillon, learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record a copy of the order dated 21.05.2015 passed by the University, whereby it has been resolved to grant the service benefits to the petitioner for the service rendered by her deceased-husband, subject to the conditions like; (i) submission of original death certificate of her husband, and (ii) completion of other office formalities and procedures as per University rules. These conditions have been imposed as the deceased-employee had not opted for pension rather had opted for CPF.

We appreciate the gesture shown by the University.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to furnish the requisite certificate and complete other official formalities within a period of two weeks. Upon doing so, we direct the University-authorities to release the requisite benefits within a period of two months.

The writ petition stands allowed in the above terms.
