Civil Writ Petition No.12662 of 2015

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.

The grouse of the petitioners is that as per date sheet for Bachelor of Laws (Five Years) Course commencing from 11.5.2015 (Annexure P/2), the examination of Paper-I Economics-2(May, 2010 Syllabus) and Paper-1 Jurisprudence-2 (May, 2012 Syllabus) was to be conducted on 10.6.2015 and 11.6.2015 respectively. The said papers were for re-appear candidates as per the date sheet itself which showed *mark against the said papers. It is the case of the petitioners that they had gone to give the examination on the above said dates at the examination centre but they were informed that examination had already been held on 11.5.2015 and 12.5.2015 and therefore reappear question papers had not been supplied and they could not give the examination. The petitioners immediately filed representation dated 12.6.2015 (Annexure P/3) to the Controller of Examinations of the respondent University regarding the said grievance.

Counsel for the respondent-University has very fairly stated that he has instructions from the University that examination of the aforesaid papers for the petitioners will be conducted at the earliest preferably within a period of two months so that the petitioners are not put to any loss of their academic year and no extra/additional fee will be charged from them.

In view of the above undertaking given by the counsel for the respondent-University, the present writ petition is disposed off by binding the University with the aforesaid undertaking given.
