Mahesh Grover, J

The petitioner impugns the order of transfer by contending that it is contrary to the transfer policy as he has been shifted from one place to another repeatedly within a short span, the details of which have been given in para no.4(ii) of the petition extracted here-below.

*“07.03.2013 -The petitioner transferred from Faridabad to Gurgaon
30.08.2013-The petitioner transferred from Gurgaon to Faridabad
03.09.2014 The petitioner transferred from Ballabhgarh (Faridabad)
to Gurgaon,
22.01.2015 -The petitioner transferred from Gurgaon to Faridabad
(NIT) and
25/26.06.2015-By the impugned order (P-4) the petitioner again
ordered to be transferred from Faridabad (NIT) to
Gurgaon.*

The aforesaid implies that the petitioner has been repeatedly shuffled between Gurgaon and Faridabad further indicating his own manipulative efforts in this regard. The reply also supports this perception and since no malice is manifest in this decision which is an administrative function of the respondents, this Court would not interfere in the exercise of its jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Dismissed.
