Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of notice dated 31.10.2014 (Annexure P/2) and notice dated 18.11.2014 (Annexure P/3) issued by respondent no.3 – Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Gurdaspur.
