Arguments have been addressed at some length. It has been brought to the notice of the court that pursuant to order dated 21st August, 2012 passed by Financial Commissioner, proceedings are pending before Commissioner. However, no progress has been made in view of order dated September 25, 2012.

After addressing arguments at some length, learned counsel agreed that proceedings before the Commissioner may be allowed to culminate. This plea appears to be reasonable.

Under the circumstances, petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to raise all their pleas before Commissioner.
