PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

On 13.10.2015 petitioner was directed to be present in Court. However, despite second call neither petitioner nor her counsel put in appearance nor costs of ₹5,000/-, imposed vide order dated 10.12.2013, have been deposited.

Dismissed for non-prosecution with costs of ₹10,000/- in addition to the costs of ₹5,000/- already imposed. The total costs of ₹15,000/- shall be deposited with the State Legal Services Authority, Punjab within a period of two months. If costs are not deposited, same shall be recovered as arrears of land revenue.

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In view of dismissal of the writ petition, CMs filed by respondent No.4 are disposed of as infructuous. However, respondent No.4 will be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
