After arguing for some time and faced with the fact that the petitioner was litigating for recognition of respondent No.1 -institute and was successful in continuation of his studies, which was upheld by the Division Bench also, the claim for refund of the fee on the ground that respondent No.1 did not have valid affiliation/recognition is not sustainable.
