It is not disputed that the petitioners had earlier approached this Court for the same relief through CWP No.18208 of 2006 titled as '**Raj Kumar and others Vs. Punjab State Electricity Board and others**'. That writ petition came up for hearing before this Court and vide order dated 10.05.2007 the same was dismissed as withdrawn, through the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner requests for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to pursue any other remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforementioned.”

The petitioner without raising any fresh cause filed the

present writ petition wherein the factum of filing of the above referred earlier writ petition has not been disclosed. Rather, the same has been willfully suppressed from the Court as in Para 15 of the present writ petition it has been stated as under:-

“That the petitioners have not filed such or similar writ petition in this Hon'ble Court or in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.”

In view of the above, the present writ petition is nothing but an abuse of the process of law and is dismissed with costs quantified at ₹25,000/-.
