HEMANT GUPTA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has challenged the finalization of development plans under Section 5 of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963, on the ground of mala-fides.

The petitioner has earlier sought time on 22.09.2014 to implead the persons against whom the petitioner wishes to level allegations of mala-fide but today, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that none on behalf of the petitioner has contacted him for the purposes of amending the writ petition so as to level specific allegations of mala-fide.

Since, the sole ground to challenge the development plans is that the same is actuated as mala-fides but in the absence of specific

allegations of mala-fide against the persons, who have not been impleaded as a party, we do not find that the challenge to the development plans in the absence of proper parties can be entertained.

Consequently, the present writ petition is dismissed.
