The petitioners have approached this Court 12 years after their services were done away with by the respondent in the year 2003. Their co-employees, who had also been so employed and some of whose pay scales were reduced, or their services were done away with by the respondent, had approached this Court by filing CWP No.15958 of 2003, which eventually came to be decided by a coordinate Bench on 28.11.2013, vide judgment (Annexure P-9). That decision was challenged in LPA No.421 of 2014, which was upheld, vide judgment dated 18.3.2014 (Annexure P-10). The SLP was also dismissed on 1.9.2014.

The petitioners now claim the same relief, as was granted in CWP No.15958 of 2003.

Learned counsel submits that they have been representing to the respondent in the meanwhile.

She further submits that the respondent, being a large organization, is constantly employing persons on contractual basis, on the

posts the petitioners were manning, i.e. Sewadars and Clerks.

A legal notice is also stated to have been issued on behalf of the petitioners to the respondent, on 5.12.2014 (Annexure P-13).

Keeping in view the fact that the respondent is a large organization and would, therefore, possibly be employing persons from time to time, and the petitioners' co-employees have eventually succeeded before this Court, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
